#2 - God is Holy (Is. 6:1-8; Ex. 3:2-6; Ex. 33:18-23)

## What does it mean that God is holy?

1. God is \_\_\_\_\_ and perfect. (Hab. 1:13; Job 34:10)
2. God is \_\_\_\_\_, above all, and distinctly \_\_\_\_\_ from anyone or anything. (Ex. 15:11; 1 Sam. 2:2; Is. 40:25)

## What does Scripture tell us about God's holiness?

- God's holiness is emphasized even on His throne in \_\_\_\_\_. (Is. 6:1-8; Rev. 4:2-11)
- God's holiness is even known by \_\_\_\_\_. (Mark 1:23-24)
- God's holiness is repeatedly shown to us throughout \_\_\_\_\_. (Lev. 19:2; Is. 57:15; Ps. 15:1, 103:1; 1 Pet. 1:14-16)
- God is holy in \_\_\_\_\_ and in His very nature. Holiness is part of His beauty and glory. (Ps. 24:3, 27:4, 145:17; Gen 1:31; Matt. 5:48; Rev. 15:3-4; James 1:17)
- God clearly wants us to \_\_\_\_\_ and see, as much as we can, His holiness.

- \_\_\_\_\_ His holiness to us. Sin had no hold on Him. (John 1:14,18; Luke 1:35; Heb. 7:25-27)
- Holiness requires that man's unholiness be addressed by \_\_\_\_\_ in order for man to have a relationship with holy God. (Rom. 7:12; Heb. 9:1-22)

## How Should This Impact Me?

- ① Recognize \_\_\_\_\_ of sin is needed because of His holiness and our unholiness.
- ② \_\_\_\_\_ about redemption and grace from a holy God. (Eph. 1:4; 1 Pet. 2:9)
- ③ \_\_\_\_\_ and worship Him for His holiness. (Ps. 71:22, 96:9, 103:1)
- ④ \_\_\_\_\_ holiness as a new creature in Christ. Live as a citizen of heaven. Hate sin. Be separated to Him above anything else. (1 Pet. 1:14-19; Rom. 12:1-2)
- ⑤ \_\_\_\_\_ to Him in service. (Is. 6:8)
- ⑥ \_\_\_\_\_ and not as a Pharisee. We can be tempted to "look holy" without having a changed heart.
- ⑦ Holiness does not mean \_\_\_\_\_ from the world. Be a person that lives \_\_\_\_\_ and reflects Holy Jesus. (Luke 7:36-50)
